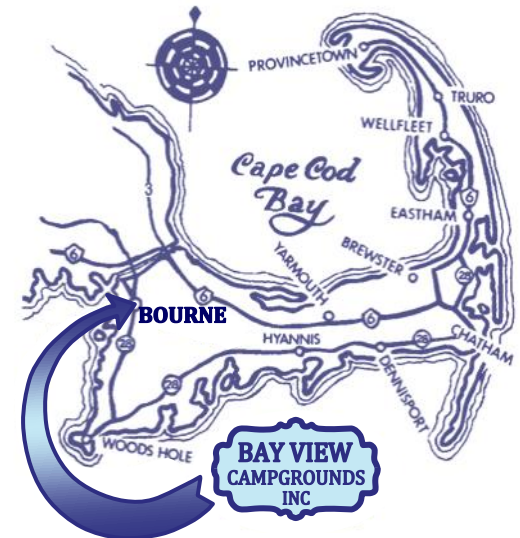
Directions

From Upstate New York, Northern New England and Western Massachusetts: Take Rte 90 (Mass Pike East) to Rte 495 South. Rte 495 South will merge with Rte 25 (Cape Cod). Travel over Bourne Bridge and *(see below)

From Boston, Plymouth and Massachusetts South Shore: Follow Rte 3 over Sagamore Bridge. Take 1st exit over the bridge. At traffic light turn left and follow Rte 6 along the canal to the Bourne Bridge rotary and *(see below)

From Connecticut, Rhode Island and Mid Atlantic States: Rte 95 North to Rte 195 (Cape Cod). Take Rte 25 (Cape Cod) and you will notice that Rte 495 merges into Rte 25 at this point. Travel over the Bourne Bridge and ***follow Rte 28 South off of rotary for 1 mile where you will see the entrance to Bay View Campground on the right.**

Sites are offered for FAMILY CAMPING, which we define as the camper, his or her spouse or partner and their unmarried children, (if applicable) and rates are based upon a family of two (2). Maximum occupancy per site is eight (8) persons. Please see insert for current rates.

Reservations can be made at our website year round or by calling 508-759-7610 between Feb 15th - Oct 15th. Next year's reservations are available after July 15th. For holiday & weekend reservations refer to "minimum stay & deposit requirements" below. The full balance of your reservation is required upon your arrival in cash, travelers checks, MasterCard, Discover or Visa. Sorry, but PERSONAL CHECKS cannot be accepted for balance due.

Site Rates are for partial (w/e/c) OR full (w/e/s/c) hookup sites. PLEASE SEE INSERT FOR CURRENT RATES. Site rates allow for 2 (two) persons, one camping unit (RV or tent) and one vehicle. Your children are charged an additional daily fee. Anyone other than your unmarried children will be registered and charged as visitors. A maximum of one additional car (\$) is allowed for a daily fee. Boats are also charged an additional daily fee and must be parked in the "Boat Storage Area", not on your site. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and fireplace.

Minimum Stay & Deposit Requirements

If you desire less than the minimum stay, please inquire & we will try our best to accommodate you if at all possible!

Weekends off season: Friday & Saturday night minimum & 2 nights fee as deposit

Weekends in season: 3 nights minimum & 2 nights deposit

Weekly Rate: 7 consecutive nights of your choice & 2 nights deposit

4th of July week: 7 nights minimum & \$150.00 deposit

Memorial Day, Labor Day and Columbus Day weekends: Friday, Saturday & Sunday nights minimum & 3 nights fee as deposit

Sunday - Thursdays: no minimum stay & 2 nights fee deposit, unless reservation is for 1 night, then deposit is 1 night fee.

A confirmed reservation with a deposit will ensure your reservation until 12 noon following your arrival date. Site will be released after that time with no refund.

Visitor Admission

All non-registered campers & guests coming to visit you must sign in and pay an admission fee.

Cancellation Policy

* Cancellations received more than 14 days in advance of arrival date will receive a full deposit refund less a \$25.00 service charge.

* Cancellations received 7 to 14 days in advance of arrival date will receive a full deposit refund less one night's fee.

* Cancellations received less than 7 days in advance of arrival date are non-refundable.

* There are no refunds for early departures. Additionally, guests who shorten their stay without 14 days prior notice of confirmed arrival date are liable for charges on the cancelled nights.

Pets

We are pleased to extend to our registered campers the privilege of allowing their pet to accompany them while at Bay View. However, be advised that there is a limit of two (2) pets per site and that we enforce our leash, waste cleanup and disturbance policies. Owners not complying will be required to find pet accommodations elsewhere.

Visitors to your site may not bring pets into the park

Motorcycles

Motorcycles, mopeds, scooters and similar motorized vehicles are not permitted to be operated in the park. There is a motorcycle parking area at the entrance of our park for those who bring their motorcycles.

Bicycles

Bicycle riding is permitted except in posted restricted areas.

Persons under 16 years must wear a helmet at all times. Bikes must be on site by dusk.
